3. For each phrase of the Preamble, decide which part of the Constitution fulfills that purpose of government. **Match** the letters from the **Parts of the U.S. Constitution** to the **Phrases of the Preamble** by writing the letter(s) from the right-hand column to the left of the phrase that it is associated with.
  - a. You will use some letters more than once.
  - b. You will use all of the letters.
  - c. Some of the phrases have more than one letter associated with it. In the “Match” column, the number of letters that correspond to each phrase is written in parenthesis.
